The Knit at Night Guild is pleased to offer a weekend workshop with Nancy Bush. Nancy is the well-known author of several knitting books, including *Folk Socks* (1994), *Folk Knitting in Estonia* (1999), *Knitting on the Road* (2001), *Knitting Vintage Socks* (2005) and *Knitted Lace of Estonia* (2008). Her many designs and articles have appeared in *Interweave Knits*, *Spin-off*, *Vogue Knitting* and *Threads*. She also has worked as a freelance designer and consultant to several yarn companies and teaches workshops throughout the United States and also abroad. Nancy Bush owns the Woolly West, a mail order and online yarn business in Salt Lake City, Utah. Her main focus and passion have been traditional knitting techniques and uses of ethnic patterns, in particular the knitting traditions of Estonia, a country she has often visited.

The classes offered are for intermediate to advanced knitters. Everyone attending is expected to already know how to cast on and off, read and follow instructions and charts, and perform increases and decreases. You may sign up for one or both classes. Please include the registration form with your check. Class size is limited to 20 participants, and is expected to fill quickly so don't delay. We will take a 1hr break for lunch on both days. There are lots of food options close by, or you can bring your lunch. We do not have a special rate for hotel rooms, but if you're planning on taking both days, there are several of us who will be staying there.

## ***“Gloves, The Elegance of Warm Hands” – Sat., 9am-4pm - \$85***

This is a new workshop that Nancy is presenting. We will study the traditions and techniques of making gloves. The history of this style of hand-covering is long and interesting, as well as romantic. We will look at traditional gloves and learn to make a perfect pair, with well-shaped fingers, several choices of thumb shapings, and some unique embellishments. A yarn kit will be provided.

## ***“Making an Estonian Lace Sampler” – Sun., 9am-4pm - \$90***

In Estonian lace knitting tradition, patterns were recorded by knitting them into a long sampler or by a collection of small sample pieces. In this class we will study this tradition and make our own sampler of Estonian lace patterns. This class is an excellent accompaniment to her latest book, *Knitted Lace of Estonia*. A yarn kit will be provided.
